Far Corner 9 Hole League Local Rules

All Courses -

- All golfers are permitted (during our league play) to move the ball up to one club length (no nearer the hole) to obtain a "preferred lie" IF THE BALL IS IN THE FAIRWAY. You may not take a "preferred lie" in the rough or on the green.
- Golfers may take a free lift from any mulched flower beds on the course.

Fox Course -

Hole #2

- If you think your ball is lost or out of bounds in the trees on the left, Hit a provisional before you move forward to look for your ball. If you can't find your ball within 3 minutes, your provisional becomes the ball in play and you'll be hitting your fourth shot.
- Or you may drop a ball 2 club lengths in the fairway equidistant from the spot your ball went in the trees. It is a 2 shot penalty. You lay 3 and will be hitting your fourth shot.

Hole #5

Left of stone wall is out of bounds.

Hole #6

• French drain on left- relief to fairway (stance and 1 club length).

Hole #7 (water hole)

- If you hit into any part of the "water penalty area", you may take your next shot from the drop area located off the cart path, near the green and in the rough. Not on the fringe. You would be hitting your 3rd or 4th shot depending on whether the ball went into the penalty area on your 1st or 2nd shot (In on 1, Out on 2; or In on 2, Out on 3).
- The ditch on the left side of the green and the section of water generally in the same area on the right side are both "lateral penalty areas".
- If you hit over the water, but the ball rolls back down into the "lateral" section of the hazard, place it up to 2 club lengths from spot it went in. The intent is to not place it nearer the hole, but this is almost impossible, so the Far Corner pro has said to just take 2 club lengths up the hill (one stroke penalty) and place the ball.

Hole #9 (water hole)

- If you hit into the "water" on the right side, you must bring the ball back behind the penalty area, keeping the point where it entered between you and the hole (or hit from where you took previous shot) w/one stroke penalty. If the pipe is in your line of sight to the pin, you may drop the ball up to two club lengths laterally with no penalty.
- If you hit into the water on the left, you may do the above OR drop the ball up to two club lengths from the point of entry (no closer to the hole) w/one stroke penalty.

Heron Course -

Hole #2 – Golfers may take a free drop (no nearer the hole) if the ball lands in the gravelly drainage ditch on the downhill section of the fairway.

Hole #4 – The ditch on the left that extends a little way into the fairway is a lateral penalty area.

Hole #5 – Golfers may take a free drop (no nearer the hole) if the ball lands in the gravelly drainage ditch on the right side of the fairway near the green.
