

**Far Corner 9 Hole Ladies League
2024 Tournament Schedule**

Date	Description and How to Score
April 16, 23	Open Play – Weather Permitting Keep your own score and get your golf swing back before league play begins.
April 30	Medal Play G&N Players keep their gross scores (total strokes). Gross scores are converted to net by applying individual handicaps.
May 7	Medal Play G&N Players keep their gross scores (total strokes). Gross scores are converted to net by applying individual handicaps.
May 14	Medal Play G&N Players keep their gross scores (total strokes). Gross scores are converted to net by applying individual handicap
May 21	Best Ball Foursome (<i>Blind Draw</i> – Foursomes will be selected via a blind draw by the Tournament Committee. Based on player preferred times. One best ball per hole of the foursome. Total score minus the average of team handicap. 1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd place winning teams.
May 28	Tee to Green Players tally only the strokes it takes to get from each tee to the green (putts don't count).
June 4	Par 4's Keep individual scores for handicap. Scoring for tournament: Count only the par 4's (Fox: 2,3,6,8) (Heron: 1,3,5,7,9). Lowest scores are winners.
June 11	Flag Day Each player gets small flag labeled with their total course handicap (Handicap plus par for 9 holes). Ex: Your handicap is 18 + 36 (par for Heron holes) = 54. In this example, if player strokes 54 they must place flag in the ground. Only players who come into the hostess with their flag would be eligible for tournament winning.

June 18	Strike 3 Players drop their three worst holes and score the best six holes for the tournament score
June 25	Fewest Putts Players total up their individual putts. Fewest putts wins.
July 2	Mutt and Jeff Players use only the scores from the par 3's and 5's for their tournament score.
July 9	3,4,5 Prior to the start of play , players pick one par 3, one par 4 and one par 5 hole to be totaled for their tournament score.
July 16	Medal Play G&N Players keep their gross scores (total strokes). Gross scores are converted to net by applying individual handicaps.
July 23	Member/Guest Tournament
July 30	Hate Me Holes Prior to the start of play , players pick 3 holes they want to eliminate from their total for their tournament score.
August 6	No Alibi Each player is allowed 2 'mulligans' to be used on any shot except a putt.
August 13	Best 5 Holes (Hawk Course) Players total only the scores from their best 5 holes for their tournament score.
August 20	Odd Holes Players tally strokes on odd holes only (1,3,5,7,9) for their tournament score.
August 27	Blind Draw Medal Play (<i>Blind Draw – Foursomes will be selected via a blind draw by the Tournament Committee. Based on player preferred times.</i>)

<p>September 3</p>	<p>Toss 1 Hole Players eliminate their worst hole from the total for the tournament score.</p>
<p>September 10</p>	<p>Revert 3 Holes to Par Players choose their three highest (over par) holes and convert them to par. Total all holes for the tournament score.</p>
<p>September 17</p>	<p>3 Clubs and a Putter Entire tournament is played with only 3 clubs and a putter. Regular scoring.</p>
<p>September 24</p>	<p>Medal Play G&N Players keep their gross scores (total strokes). Gross scores are converted to net by applying individual handicaps.</p>
<p>October 1</p>	<p>Best Ball Twosome (Chose partner from within tee time) One best ball per score of the twosome for each hole. Total score minus the average of your two handicaps. 1st thru 6th place twosome winners.</p>
<p>October 8</p>	<p>Open Play – Closing Banquet</p>
