| $\begin{gathered} \text { April } \\ \mathbf{3 0} \end{gathered}$ | Medal Play G\&N <br> Players keep their gross scores (total strokes). Gross scores are converted to net by applying individual handicaps. |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { May } \\ 7 \end{gathered}$ | Medal Play G\&N <br> Players keep their gross scores (total strokes). Gross scores are converted to net by applying individual handicaps. |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { May } \\ 14 \end{gathered}$ | Medal Play G\&N <br> Players keep their gross scores (total strokes). Gross scores are converted to net by applying individual handicap |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { May } \\ 21 \end{gathered}$ | Best Ball Foursome (Blind Draw - Foursomes will be selected via a blind draw by the Tournament Committee. Based on player preferred times. One best ball per hole of the foursome. Total score minus the average of team handicap. $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }} \& 3^{\text {rd }}$ place winning teams. |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { May } \\ 28 \end{gathered}$ | Tee to Green <br> Players tally only the strokes it takes to get from each tee to the green (putts don't count). |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { June } \\ \hline \end{gathered}$ | Par 4's <br> Keep individual scores for handicap. Scoring for tournament: Count only the par 4's (Fox: 2,3,6,8) (Heron: 1,3,5,7,9). Lowest scores are winners. |
| June 11 | Flag Day <br> Each player gets small flag labeled with their total course handicap (Handicap plus par for 9 holes). Ex: Your handicap is $18+36$ (par for Heron holes) $=54$. In this example, if player strokes 54 they must place flag in the ground. Only players who come into the hostess with their flag would be eligible for tournament winning. |


| $\begin{gathered} \text { June } \\ 18 \end{gathered}$ | Strike 3 <br> Players drop their three worst holes and score the best six holes for the tournament score |

| $\begin{gathered} \text { June } \\ 25 \end{gathered}$ | Fewest Putts <br> Players total up their individual putts. Fewest putts wins. |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { July } \\ 2 \end{gathered}$ | Mutt and Jeff <br> Players use only the scores from the par 3's and 5's for their tournament score. |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { July } \\ 9 \end{gathered}$ | 3,4,5 <br> Prior to the start of play, players pick one par 3, one par 4 and one par 5 hole to be totaled for their tournament score. |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { July } \\ 16 \end{gathered}$ | Medal Play G\&N <br> Players keep their gross scores (total strokes). Gross scores are converted to net by applying individual handicaps. |

| $\begin{gathered} \text { July } \\ \mathbf{3 0} \end{gathered}$ | Hate Me Holes <br> Prior to the start of play, players pick 3 holes they want to eliminate from their total for their tournament score. |
| $\underset{6}{\text { August }}$ | No Alibi <br> Each player is allowed 2 'mulligans' to be used on any shot except a putt. |
| August 13 | Best 5 Holes (Hawk Course) <br> Players total only the scores from their best 5 holes for their tournament score. |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { August } \\ 20 \end{gathered}$ | Odd Holes <br> Players tally strokes on odd holes only $(1,3,5,7,9)$ for their tournament score. |
| $\begin{gathered} \text { August } \\ 27 \end{gathered}$ | Blind Draw Medal Play (Blind Draw - Foursomes will be selected via a blind draw by the Tournament Committee. Based on player preferred times. |
